SECURITY ASSISTANT (MOTOR TRANSPORT) EXAMINATION 2016

Online applications are invited from Indian Nationals for direct recruitment to the post of Security Assistant (Motor Transport), General Central Service, Group-'C' (Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) in the Intelligence Bureau, (Ministry of Home Affairs), Government of India. The eligibility criteria for the post is as follows:

Age limit : Upto 30 years

- ◆ Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST and by 3 years for OBC candidates.
- ◆ Upper age limit is relaxable for departmental candidates upto 40 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time.
- ◆ The age limit is relaxable up to age of 35 years for general candidates and upto 40 years for SC/ST in case of widows, divorced women and women judicially separated from their husbands and not remarried.
- ◆ The age limit is relaxable for ex-servicemen as well as for candidates who were domicile in J&K from Jan 01, 1980 to Dec 31, 1989 as well as the children and dependents of victims of communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat as per the Government instructions in this regard issued by the Central Government from time to time.

NOTE:

- The candidates can apply against vacancy of only one SIB subject to the condition that he/she possesses domicile certificate of that state and would, thus, be considered for vacancies earmarked for the said SIB only.
- While filling in the online application form, the applicant should carefully decide about his/her choice of SIB.
- SIB, once opted, will NOT be changed under any circumstances.
- Applications received from a candidate for more than one SIB would be rejected.
- The above mentioned vacancies are not reserved for any category of physically handicapped (HH, OH, VH) persons. Hence, they **NEED NOT** apply.
- The number of vacancies is provisional and liable to change.
- The posts are temporary but are likely to continue indefinitely.
- The eligibility of the candidates in terms of age, educational qualification, caste/category, domicile certificate, driving license, experience, etc. will be determined on the closing date. The candidate must be matriculate or equivalent from a recognized Board, i.e., the final result must be out on or before the closing date, i.e. **Aug 6, 2016 (till 23:59 hours)** and he/she must have been declared successful in it.

2. **SERVICE LIABILITY:** The post involves All India Service liability. **Therefore, the Candidates willing to serve anywhere in India only need to apply.**

3. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

Skill Test (Driving and motor mechanism) The candidates would be required to drive a motor vehicle as directed by the instructor. Practical knowledge of the candidates about the vehicle and removal of minor defects/snags in the vehicle, its upkeep and maintenance, etc. would be tested.	Max Marks - 100 50 marks for driving test and 50 marks for motor mechanism
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4. **SELECTION OF CANDIDATES:** The eligible candidates will be called for the skill test, the date, place and time of which would be intimated to the candidates at their Email-ID provided at the time of online registration. The candidates would also have an option to download their admit cards if they do not receive it by email. Based on the performance of the candidates in the skill test (driving and motor mechanism), they will be selected subject to successful completion of their Character and Antecedent verification followed by medical examination. The skill test need not necessarily be conducted at the centre opted and may be conducted at a centre by clubbing candidates of nearby centres. However, the candidate would be considered against the centre opted by him.

5. HOW TO APPLY:

- Applications should be submitted **ONLINE** only by logging on to the website **www.mha.nic.in**. Applications will **NOT** be accepted through any other mode.
- Online registration will become operational from the date of publication of the advertisement in the Employment News, i.e. **July 16, 2016, till 23:59 hours** of the closing date, i.e. **Aug 6, 2016**. Registration done prior to **Jul 16, 2016** and after **Aug 6, 2016** will not be entertained.
- The candidate has to opt for a centre against whose vacancy he/she wishes to apply depending upon the number of vacancies in various categories. The candidate must be a domicile of the state/UT of the opted centre as on closing date. The candidates have to intimate the details of their LMV driving license and domicile certificate in the online registration process. Any variation detected in these details at the time of skill test could render the candidate ineligible.
- The candidates are required to upload their photograph and signature (in a single file the size of which should not be more than 50 KB) at the time of online registration itself. Sufficient number of copies of the photograph may please be retained for use in future.
- Before submitting the online applications, the candidates must preview the application to ensure that they have provided correct information and uploaded correct photograph and signature.** It must also be ensured that the photograph and signature are visible and not hazy/blurred, otherwise the photograph and signature should be uploaded again or the page should be reloaded or refreshed. The online application should be submitted only after ensuring that the information / photograph / signature are correct.
- Candidates may ensure that the signatures uploaded by them are visible since they (candidates) would be required to append signature on admit cards and attendance sheets during subsequent stages of examination and any variation in signature could render them unfit for the examination.

6. **EXAMINATION FEE:** Rs. 50/- (Rupees Fifty only). Only male candidates belonging to Unreserved and OBC category are required to pay the fee. **All SC/ST and all female candidates are exempted from payment of examination fee.**

6.1 **MODE OF PAYMENT:** The candidates would be required to take a printout of challan form (wherein name of the applicant, his/her Registration number, etc. will be printed) and deposit the fee in cash in any branch of State Bank of India after a gap of one working day. No other mode of payment is allowed.

6.2 **Those candidates who apply on the closing date can deposit the fees in any State Bank of India branch on Aug 8 & 9, 2016.**

7. **CLOSING DATE: Aug 6, 2016 (till 23:59 hours).**

WARNING

It has been noticed that some unscrupulous elements are fraudulently inviting applications for various posts in the Intelligence Bureau.
